- TOP (Test of Oral Proficiency) exam before first TA quarter, if a non-native English speaker
- TA training course 495 in Spring of first year

- 444 in Fall, Winter, and Spring quarters of second year
- Practical phonetics exam, or completion of 103 with a B or higher*
